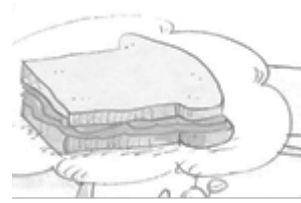


Peanut Butter and Jelly
